

On Monday, May 17, 2010 the T.C.D.A. Board of Directors held a meeting at Coopers Pub. Of interest from that meeting are the following items:

1. Election Results:

The following individuals were elected to 2 year terms beginning in July 2010:

2. Divisional Advisor change:

Dave Burton will no longer be Divisional Advisor for the Pub Fun Triples League. We thank Dave for his service. Tim Wennermark has agreed to take on the responsibility of Divisional Advisor for the Pub Fun Triples League. Thanks Tim.

3. Tournament Director:

Following a successful Dartmania Tournament, T.C.D.A. Tournament Director Ryan Loch has resigned his position. Ryan will continue to assist the new Tournament Director. Thanks Ryan for all of your hard work. Karen Ekstrom has agreed to take on the responsibility of Tournament Director for the T.C.D.A. . Thanks Karen!

4. Change to the T.C.D.A. Rules and Procedures:

The T.C.D.A. Board voted to make a change in Article V. The present Article V is shown below.

ARTICLE V DIVISIONS

Section 1 -The TCDA divides itself into Leagues, which are subdivided into Divisions. Divisions are made up of Teams.

Section 2 - When Divisions are not divided geographically, the general rule shall be to advance the top two Division winners of the current season to the next higher Division, with the bottom two finishers, starting with AA Division, falling back into the next lower Division.

Section 3 - The Scheduling Committee shall be the final authority in assigning Teams to Divisions.

The Board voted to change Section 2 to read as follows:

Section 2 - The general rule shall be to advance the Division winners of the current season to the next higher Division, with the bottom finisher, starting with AA Division, falling back into the next lower Division.

5. Classic Division Alignment:

The T.C.D.A. Board addressed a numerical and competitive imbalance in certain Classic League divisions. The most significant imbalances were in the AA Division where the bottom finishers are simply non-competitive and in the C Division that had 3 teams.

The T.C.D.A. Board approved a motion to make the AA Division a 6 team division and directed that there may be no expansion of this Division until such time as all lower divisions are full.

The Board further directed the Scheduling Committee to assign teams to Divisions in a manner that equalizes, to the extent possible, the number of teams in the A, B and C divisions.
